**SUBJECT: NOC FOR RE-EXPORT OF GOODS IMPORTED IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE IMPORT POLICY ORDER 2016**

The undersigned is directed to refer to Federal Board of Revenue Office Memorandum C.No. 5(3) Tar-I/2018 dated 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2018 on the above subject.

2. It is to inform that proviso 4 of para-19 of IPO 2016, provides for re-export of goods denied import subject to the laws and regulations pertaining to trade of contraband goods. However, if the importer does not seek re-export of goods imported which are of sub-standard quality that are affecting public health including short self-life medicines or pharmaceutical raw materials or edible products imported in contravention of IPO 2016, shall be destroyed within a period of six months without offering any release as per proviso 3 of para-19 of IPO 2016.
